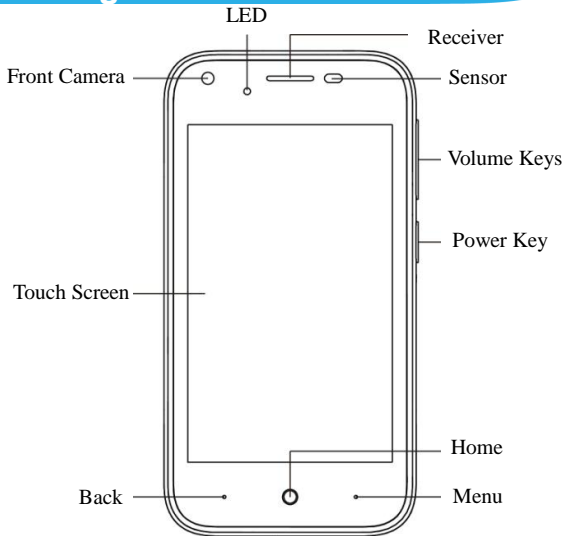

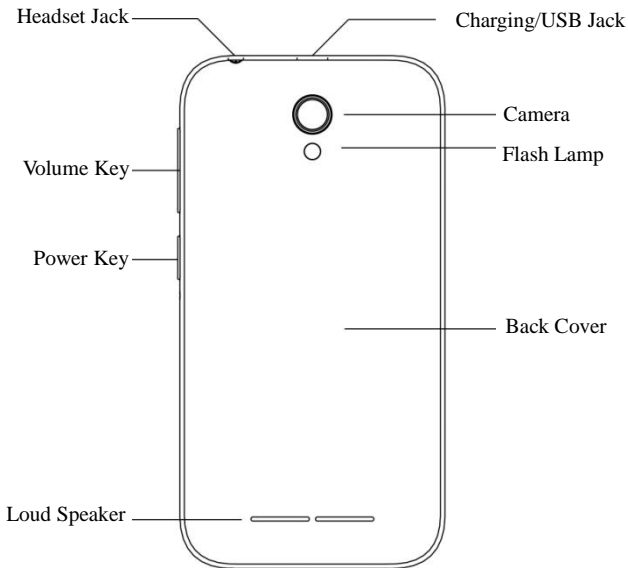

Getting to Know Your Phone





Power Key

- Press and hold to power on, select phone modes, turn on/off airplane mode, or restart, or power off.
- Press to wake up your phone.

Home Key

- Touch to return to the Home Screen from any application or screen.
- Hold to see Google search.

Menu Key

Touch and hold to see recently used applications.

Back Key

Touch to go to the previous screen.

Volume Keys

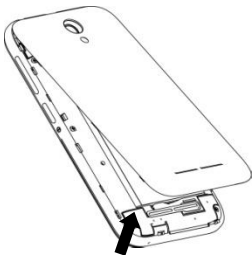
Press or hold to turn the volume up or down. Control the in call volume during a call, music and games volume when using media, or control the Ring volume from the home screen. Press Volume Down and the Power key to do a screen capture.

Starting Up

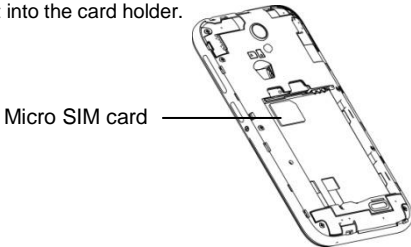
Switch off your phone before installing or replacing the battery or the SIM card. The microSDHC™ card is optional and is

used to add more media storage eg. for Photos and Music.
Unmount the microSDHC card before removing it.

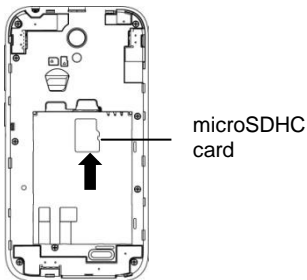
1. Place your finger in the slot at the bottom of the back cover to lift and remove the cover.



2. Hold the SIM card with its cut corner oriented as shown and slip it into the card holder.



3. Hold your microSDHC card with the metal contacts facing down and slide it into the microSDHC card slot.



4. Align the connectors on the phone and the battery and slide the battery into the compartment. Then gently press the battery down until it is secured.

5. Align the back cover with the back of the phone and press the cover back into place. Make sure all the tabs are secure and there are no gaps around the cover.

Charging the Battery

1. Connect the adapter to the charging jack. Ensure that the adapter is inserted with the correct orientation. Do not force the connector into the charging jack.






2. Connect the charger to a standard AC power outlet.
3. Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged.


Powering On/Off Your Phone

Make sure the battery is charged before powering on.


- Press and hold the **Power Key** to turn on your phone.
- To turn it off, press and hold the **Power Key** to open the options menu. Touch **Power off**.


Make and Answer Calls

On the home screen, touch the  button to open the Dialler. Touch a recently called number or press  to open the Dial Pad and touch  to make the call.

Answer an incoming Call - Slide the  icon from middle to right to answer the call.

Messaging

Touch the Messaging icon on the home screen. Touch  to write a new message. Add the phone number, text and press

 to send.

Connect to a Computer

1. Connect using a USB lead. Install the PC drivers if required then select MTP on the handset to browse the handset folders on your PC.
2. Use Google Drive to share files in the cloud.
3. Connect via Bluetooth to share files with other devices.

MAC users need to download the File Transfer app from Android onto your MAC device.
