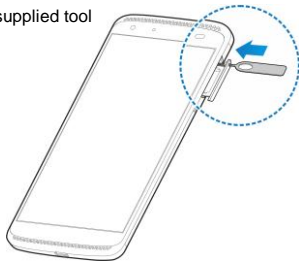




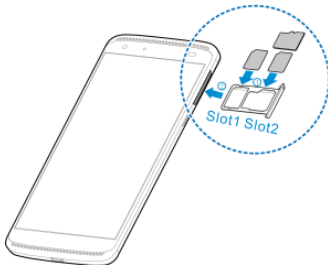
Installing the nano-SIM / microSDHC Card

Switch off your phone before installing the nano-SIM or microSDHC card.

1. Open the card holder using the supplied tool



2. Hold the nano-SIM / microSDHC as shown and insert into the card holder.



Charging the Battery



1. Connect the adapter to the charging jack.
2. Connect the charger to a standard AC power outlet.
3. Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged.

WARNING!

Use only ZTE-approved chargers and cables. The use of unapproved accessories could damage your phone or cause the battery to explode.

CAUTION:

Do not change the built-in rechargeable battery in your phone by yourself. The battery can only be changed by ZTE or ZTE authorised service provider.

NOTE:

- If the battery is extremely low, you may be unable to power on the phone even when it is being charged. In this case, try again after charging the phone for at least 30 minutes. Contact customer service if you still cannot power on the phone after prolonged charging.
- The battery is not removable, do not remove the rear cover please.
- Press and hold the power key for about 10 seconds to force the mobile phone restart.

Menu key	Touch the key to open the most recently used applications screen.
Home key	Touch it to open the home screen. If you're viewing the left or right extended home screen, Touch it to open the central home screen.
Back key	Touch it to open the previous screen you were working in. If the onscreen keyboard is open, touch it to close the keyboard.
Power key	Press it to turn on/off the display. Long press it to open a menu with options for Airplane mode, for Silent mode, for Vibration mode, and for powering off the phone.
Volume keys	Adjust the volume. Long press it to quickly adjust the ring tone volume to maximum or minimum. Press to access the Interruptions panel Press to control in call volume Press to control media and apps volume
