

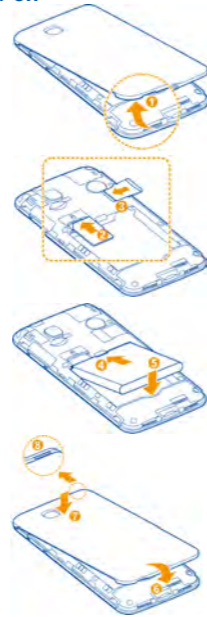

Power on



NOTE: If the battery is extremely low, you may be unable to power on the phone even when it is being charged. In this case, try again after charging the phone for at least 10 minutes. Contact customer service if you still cannot power on the phone after prolonged charging.

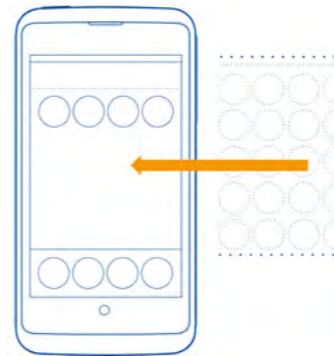
Unlock phone

Drag the arrow to the right to unlock your phone. If the screen is off, press the Power button.



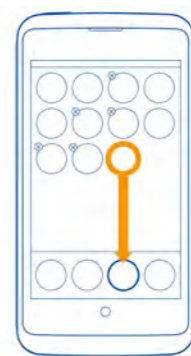
Navigate Home

Use Search to discover content or swipe left to access all your apps.



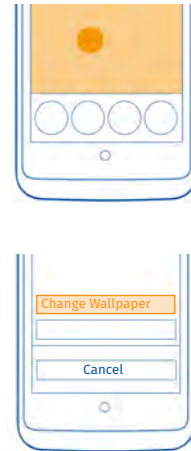
Personalize Home

Touch and hold an icon to move it within the grid or in and out of the dock. Touch the "x" to delete it. Touch Home to finish editing.



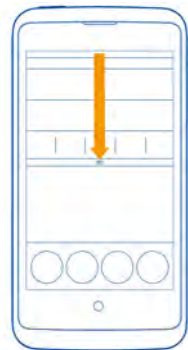
Customize wallpaper

Touch and hold the wallpaper to select or create a new one.



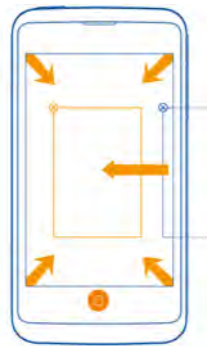
Open notifications

Swipe down from the Status Bar to see notifications, quick settings, and your mobile data use. Touch a notification to go to the related app.



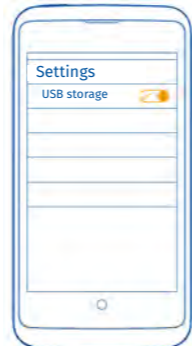
Switch applications

Connect to a computer

Turn on USB storage in the phone settings to transfer all your photos, music and video.



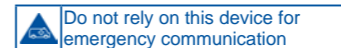
Manage mobile data

Turn your Internet connection on and off from the Settings app or quick settings.
