Key Functions

Keys and Icons	Function
Power Key	Hold down to power on your phone. Press to switch to sleep mode. Press to wake up. Hold down for Silent mode, Airplane mode or Power off.
Back 	Press to go to the previous screen. Press to exit applications.
Home 	Press to return to the Home Screen from any screen. Hold down to access Google Search
Options 	Press to get the options on the current screen. Hold down to see the recently used applications.
Volume Keys	Use to control the volume Up and Down

Keys and Icons**Function**

Phone icon – Open the dialer for Calls



Contacts – Open your Phonebook for all your Contacts



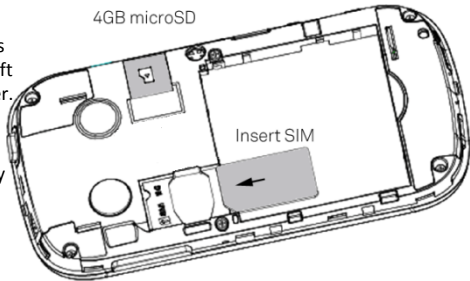
Apps – Open the Applications menu



Messages – go to the Messages app, for SMS and MMS

Insert the SIM Card

1. Open the back cover using the thumb catch at the base of the device
2. Hold the SIM card with the gold contacts facing down and the cut corner facing left as shown and slide it into the card holder. Push it fully home.
3. Your handset includes a 4GB memory card. If you wish to increase the memory capacity insert a microSD card up to 32GB with the metal contacts facing down as shown above.
4. Insert the battery taking care to line up the gold contacts.
5. Replace the cover and snap down to shut securely.



Switch your device On or Off, Charge your battery

- Press and hold the **Power Key** to turn on your phone.
- To turn it off, press and hold the **Power Key** to open the options menu.
- Touch **Power off** and then touch **OK**.

Insert the charger lead carefully.

Ensure the plug is inserted with the correct orientation.

Do not force the connector into the charger jack.

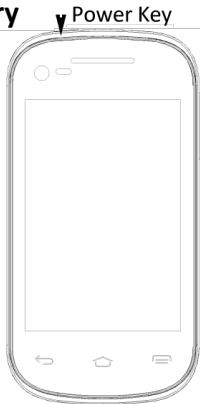
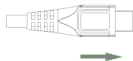
Connect the charger to a standard AC wall outlet.

Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged.

If the phone is on, you'll see the charging icon  /  on the status bar.

How much charge have you got?

If the battery is low, there will be a pop-up message on the screen. As you charge your phone, the lock screen will tell you the battery level each time you wake up your phone.



Setting Up for the First Time

When you first power on your phone or after a factory reset you need to enter some settings before use.





















1. Touch the Android logo to begin. The default language is English (New Zealand) touch Change language if required
2. Select **Create, Sign in** to enter a Google account or **Skip** to set up later.
3. Configure the Google location options and touch **Next**.
4. You will be prompted to accept the terms of Google service. Touch **Next** to continue.
5. Set your Location preferences
6. Touch **Finish** to complete the setup.
7. Further assistance is given in the form of pop ups describing how to use various features. Press OK to clear these notices.

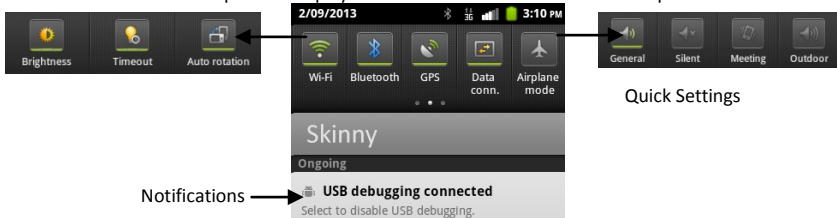

The Notifications and Quick Settings Panel
